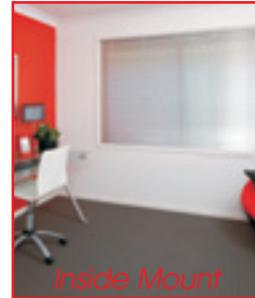

Measuring Guide

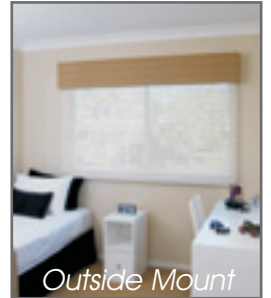
Here is a general overview of how to measure for your blinds. Should you have any questions or need any further assistance just ask one of our Redeblinds team members.

Firstly measure like the professionals do, always use a metal measuring tape. A dressmakers tape or ruler will not give you accurate enough measurements to ensure your blinds will fit correctly.

You need to decide where you would like the blinds to sit. Your blinds can either be inside mount, where the blinds fit into the reveal of the window for a neater look, or outside mount where the blinds cover the entire window opening. Outside mount blinds can be useful to block more light as well as hiding out of square or older windows.



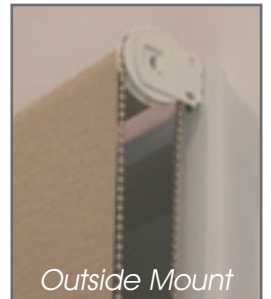

Inside Mount

① If you decide to have your blinds **inside mount** make sure you have enough room for them to fit properly. Look out for handles, tiles and the like as these may hinder the operation of your blinds. Check the product specification sheet for the required window depth for the blinds you are considering.

The other thing to remember with blinds that are **inside mount** is to be aware that there will always be a gap at the sides to allow the blinds to be raised and lowered without catching.

② Most window types have an edge on the window so privacy may not be an issue. However, some windows are designed so that the glass is flush with the reveal. In this case you may wish to **outside mount** your blinds if privacy is of concern to you. Check the product specification sheet for the allowance required for your blinds.



③ To measure for inside mount it's best to always measure the width of the opening first and write it down before you measure the drop. We recommend that you measure right at the top here where the track will fit. You should also measure in a few other positions just to check for squareness. Look for any obstruction like handles or tiles that may get in the way. Measure in millimetres to the nearest millimetre.



④ Now you can measure the drop. Measure in three places along the opening to check for squareness; left side, centre and right side. Write down your measurement. Measure in millimetres to the nearest millimetre.

Always double check your measurements.

It is very important to write down the exact measurements when measuring for inside mount blinds. Redeblinds will make the necessary deductions from the measurements you provide so that yours will look like a professional installation job!

Outside Mount



Outside Mount

Should you choose to have your blinds **outside mount** you then need to decide just how far past the window opening you wish your blinds finish. Redeblinds will make no deductions to the measurements you provide for outside mount blinds.

Most **outside mount** blinds are measured from the outside of the architrave on one side, to the outside of the architrave on the other side. However, some windows do not have an architrave fitted, or you may choose to fit the blinds to the wall above the window for greater coverage. The choice is yours.

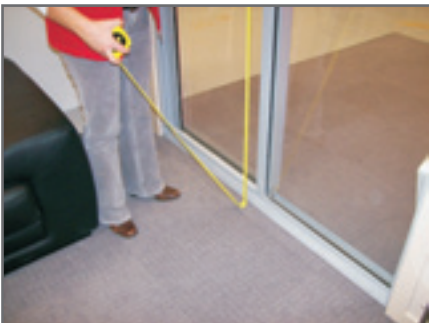


① Firstly measure the width taking into account how far past the window opening you wish your blinds to finish. Again as the head rail will be mounted to the top, this is the best place to measure the width taking care in avoiding handles, mullions or any other obstructions. Write the measurement down on the Redeblinds measuring guide in millimetres to the nearest millimetre.

② Measure the height to ensure you get the coverage you require and write it down. Measure in several places along the window checking for obstructions.



Remember for outside mount blinds Redeblinds makes no deductions to your measurements so you need to decide just how far past the window opening you wish your blinds to sit. For doorways you may wish to deduct for carpet, mats or just clearance from the floor.



Always double check your measurements.
